nueve 9	diez 10 How Old Are You?				The letter 'c' is pronounced like an English 'th' when in front of an 'i' or 'e', e.g. cero [zero], cinco [five].
		How old I am y			In Spain, the letter 'z' is always pronounced like an English 'th', e.g. diez [ten].
Tengo siete años. I am s		l am sev	n years old	In Spain, the letter 'v' is pronounced 'b', e.g. nueve [nine].	
¿Cuántos años tienes? Tengo ocho años.					The letters 'll' are pronounced 'y' like in 'yesterday', e.g. me llamo [I'm called] . The letter ' n ' is pronounced 'nye' like in ' <u>n</u> ew', e.g. señor [sir, Mr] . The letters ' gu ' only appear before the vowels 'e' and 'i' and the 'u' is always silent, e.g. ¿Qué tal? [How are you?].
