
What is the total cost?

To find the total cost, you need to add the Relevant amounts.




How much change?

To find how much change you receive, you need to find the difference (subtract).

Different combinations of coins can be used to make the same amount of money.




Key Vocabulary


Money	How we pay for things. In the UK we have pounds and pence.
Pounds (£)	One pound equals 100 pence
Total	How much it costs altogether.
Change	The difference between the total cost and how much money is paid.
Price	How much one item costs.

Representations

Bar model



Helps with finding total cost and change given. This bar model represents £1 - 80p




Part whole model

Can be used to partition amounts of money.



Making connections

> < and = can be used to compare amounts of money
